

David Latour Landed a Pair of Top Tens at South Boston on Saturday

ADVANCE, N.C. — June 21, 2010 — Team Full Throttle (TFT) driver, David Latour, pulled in two strong finishes on Saturday in the NASCAR Whelen All-American Series Late Model Twin 75's race at South Boston Speedway, in South Boston, Va. Running as high up as 3rd, Latour finished the day with a solid 7th and 5th among a very stacked field.

In the night's first race, Latour started in 12th out of 28 cars following qualifying.

"We picked off two cars right away on the top," said Latour. "The car was turning too good in the center of the corner, so that made it difficult to pass cars because it would get loose on the bottom underneath other cars. But, we were still able to pick them off one by one and got to 7th at the end."

His finish in the first 75-lap feature would line him up in 7th for the start of the second feature race.

"The second race had a few early cautions," said Latour. "I got up to 3rd behind Phillip Morris and we tried passing him for 2nd. Yet, with about 15 laps or so left the car started getting really loose. We fell back some in the closing laps and ended up in 5th."

Despite losing a little ground at the end, Latour was pleased with his 5th place finish, especially given some of the strong competition on Saturday. Drivers in the 28-car field included three-time NASCAR Whelen All-American Series National Champion, Phillip Morris, C.E. and Wesley Falk, Woody Howard and all of the usual South Boston regulars.

"It was a huge field and it felt good to finish so well against those guys," said Latour.

Latour, who was 6th in the South Boston Speedway points going into Saturday's races will race at South Boston again on Friday, July 2 for the NASCAR Whelen Late Model 200.
