

## David Latour Clenches 5th Place Points Finish at South Boston Speedway

**ADVANCE, N.C. — September 8, 2010** — [Team Full Throttle](#) (TFT) driver, David Latour, finished out his successful first season in the competitive Late Model Stock division at South Boston Speedway by claiming 5th in overall points. Racing his #89 car in the GCR Presents Spaulding Equipment Night 150 on Saturday, Latour crossed the line in 8th which was just enough to maintain the 5th points spot he had been working to secure all season.

With it being South Boston Speedway's last feature of the racing season, it was another close night in qualifying times. Latour clocked in 7th. After some close hard racing, Latour's 8th place finish was just what he needed to keep his 5th place in year end track points.

"After breaking a valve in the motor last week and not finishing the race we were hoping for another good finish this week," said Latour. "With the high level of competition at South Boston Speedway and it being our first year racing here we are very excited to finish 5th place in track points."

Latour will race again at Motor Mile Speedway, Radford, Va. for the "Shelor Motor Mile, Star County & Motor Mile Speedway Present: Customer Appreciation Night." The 150-lap NASCAR Whelen All American Late Model Stock Car Division race will be on Saturday, September 11, 2010.
