

## **David Latour Scores Two Seconds at South Boston**

**ADVANCE, N.C. — May 31, 2010** — Team Full Throttle (TFT) driver, David Latour, finished out his weekend with a pair of strong seconds in the twin 75 lap races at South Boston Speedway on Sat-urday.

Latour's No. 89 NASCAR Whelen All-American Series Late Model Stock was solid in practice, even with water seeping on the track in turns one and two. A strong qualifying run put Latour in fourth for the start of the first race.

After the pole sitter spun on the first green, the field lined up for a restart. When the green flag flew, Latour make his move for third right from the start and fell into line behind Stacy Puryear and Matt Waltz. Latour ran third until there were 40 laps to go, making an inside move off turn two for sec-ond. After a final caution, the leader had a strong restart and Latour made a charge but only had time to get back to his bumper, finishing in second.

His finish in the first race put Latour in second for the next race. He fell back to third on the start and raced there for over 60 laps until a series of cautions at the end mixed things up a bit. Latour was running in fourth when the leader cut a right front tire and got together with the car in third. That put Latour in second for the final four laps when he tried to get by the leader and simply ran out of time, making it a pair of seconds for the night.

"We're definitely happy with two seconds," said Latour. "It was a wild last few laps there in the sec-ond race, and our car was tight most of the race. We missed just a little on the adjustment between races, but the team did a great job all night and we're just happy to have finished two races in con-tention for the win. Thanks to everyone on the crew, and to all the fans for coming out on a holiday weekend to watch us race. I also want to thank all of our troops who are fighting for our freedom all over the world - that's what this weekend is all about."

Latour will race his Jeffrey Cornatzer Auto Body and Global Graphics car again at South Boston on June 19th and possibly a few additional races in the meantime. Latour will also be celebrating his high school graduation on June 12th from Davie High School.
